Buckhannon Police Department 2012 Events

The Citizens Police Academy

The 2012 Citizens Police Academy was the first in ten years. Chief Gregory and Lieutenant Loudin navigated laws and enforcement with the eighteen participants. The goal was to increase the participants' knowledge of the Police Department by illustrating how police departments work and what resources are available to them. The ten week class dove into writing reports, the laws of arrests, and 911 operations. Highlights of the course were the firsthand experience with crime scene investigation and the weaponry demonstration.



Naming of Safety Frog

2012 marked the naming of the safety frog in a joint effort with, partner in education, Upshur County Head Start. Incorporating a democracy lesson, votes were submitted to the Police Department from every Head Start. From there, the name was chosen by a committee. The winning class was Mrs. Bailey's and the name P.O.K.E.S an acronym for Police Officers Keep Everyone Safe. P.O.K.E.S made a special visit to their classroom.



Head Start Fun Day

Held at the National Guard Armory, this is a day that provides Head Start children and their parents with a chance to come out and learn about the community, health options, and safety while having fun! The Police Department sets up a booth and has POKES and an officer on hand to answer questions and to educate the children on various ways to stay safe.

Rachel's Challenge Field Day

The Buckhannon Police Department assisted with this event for students in 3rd grade through High School by having an informational booth set up that helped educate the students about the harmful effects of alcohol and drug usage. This was one of many educational opportunities on hand that gave students something constructive to do during their down time in between events.

Bike Ride with Cops Event

This event is held at the Stockert Youth Center annually for children who attend Camp Buccaneer. Children bring their bikes and learn bike safety. They also get to enjoy a ride to the river walk with the officers.



UCARE Pool Parties

UCARE is a partnership that the Department has with various community organizations / citizens to help reduce underage drinking. In 2012, officers chaperoned many of the pool events held at the high school. The goal of the pool parties is to give middle school and high school children a safe and fun alternative to drinking.



National Night Out

National Night Out is an event held in communities across the country to bring citizens together to combat crime and drug use. 2012 marked over 7 years BPD has organized a National Night Out for Upshur County. This year BPD teamed up with UCARE to organize the event. NNO is a family friendly, educational, safe, and fun evening to allow the community to become familiar with officers/ first responders. Attendants are also able to educate themselves on services local public safety agencies provide. Many booths are set up in addition to a car show, musical entertainment, and free swimming to appeal to groups of all ages.



Community Policing

In early September 2012, the police department provided training to Head Start faculty and staff on topics such as: Drug issues and recognition, Domestic Violence and Traffic Law update / Traffic safety.

Children's Festival

Members of the Buckhannon Police Department participated in the 2012 Children's Festival by setting up a booth and bike rodeo. Staff was on hand to fit children in the appropriately sized helmet, provide safety literature, answer questions, and assist children in navigating the bike rodeo course.



BUMS Forensic Unit

Mrs. Sharp's gifted class participated in the Forensic Unit in 2012. The Unit covered the entire investigation process from report writing to a mock crime scene and investigation to a mock trial. The Unit's purpose was to familiarize students with the justice system with an underlying theme relating to the consequences of peer pressure and the use of drugs and alcohol. Studies show that peer pressure with drug and alcohol use is a problem that children are now facing at a much younger age than before; showing the consequences to the actions demonstrated in the crime scene proved to be beneficial.



Halloween Safety

Members of the Buckhannon Police Department take the Halloween Safety program to all preschool - 2nd grade students in the City of Buckhannon. Officers teach the participants how to remain safe while Trick or Treating by utilizing what they have learned about “Stranger Danger” and “Pedestrian Safety”. In 2012, the program reached over 600 students. This year BPD introduced a newly renovated Halloween City and Halloween Safety Super Hero.



Red Ribbon Week

In 2012 City Officers assisted in spreading the message of Red Ribbon Week across Upshur County. Red Ribbon Week is an outreach program aimed at educating the community, specifically school aged children, on the dangers of drug use. It encompasses educational activities and presentations given by officers. The Police Department’s goal is to show the effects of drug use on the student’s health and the legal repercussions that they could face.



SERVICES

Fingerprinting – The Buckhannon Police Department offers applicant fingerprinting services at a rate of \$5 per fingerprint card. 49 utilized this service in 2012.



Traffic School – The Buckhannon Police Department oversees the instruction in the City of Buckhannon Traffic School. In 2012, 70 students participated in the Traffic School.
