

Buckhannon Police Department Volunteers In Police Service (VIPS) Program 2024 Annual Report



Membership and training

- VIPS began 2024 with eleven active members, and had two deactivations during the year. We trained three new members during the year to end 2024 with 12 active members.
- We continue to enhance our member training to align with the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) National Incident Management System (NIMS).
- Our training covers ethics, basic medical, basic search and rescue, basic fire suppression, traffic and crowd
 management, basic and advanced disaster / multi casualty incident (MCI) management, as well as other
 topics and skills. In 2023, we began aligning our training schedule with that of the police officers to better
 achieve CALEA standards. With the exception of the firearms training and the state police academy, VIPS
 members and BPD officers will receive almost identical training.
- A current list of training requirements and recommendations is listed on pages 8-9.

Attended Events

- VIPS were requested for and participated in 115 public and private events in 2024 by providing traffic
 control, foot patrols, and enhancing public relations between law enforcement and our community. There
 was one public health related event and were no emergency responses.

Hours Volunteered

- In addition to assisting with the previously listed events, VIPS members also assisted the department with administrative tasks, business security checks and by performing ride along details with officers.
- VIPS volunteered over 2108 hours during 2024, allowing officers to tend to other enforcement related situations during those hours and potentially saving the city over \$59,000.00 in labor. (Savings are calculated based on the current value of a volunteer hour for the state of West Virginia, which is \$28.17 according to www.independentsector.org. For comparison, the overall national value of a volunteer hour is \$33.49.)
- The chart on page 2 breaks down VIPS 2024 hours by month and member. Our annual hours are tracked from December 1 November 30.

Ten Year Anniversary of VIPS (2014-2024)

In 2014, Chief Matt Gregory envisioned a volunteer group within the city police department that could assist officers with public relations. Chief Gregory held several discussions with Steve Wykoff, the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) coordinator at the time. Shortly after those brainstorming sessions, the VIPS program was born. A grant was applied for and received, and initial uniforms and equipment were acquired. The inaugural meeting was held on October 22, 2014 with the five original members. Of those five founding members, two are still active with VIPS today (David Rowan and Steve Wykoff).

Over the course of the past ten years, the role of VIPS has changed and increased well beyond the initial vision. VIPS continues to assist with public relations and outreach, and now provides assistance to the officers with traffic and crowd management, education and presentations, emergency response, and general security. We currently have 12 active members, and had over 50 community members wear the VIPS uniform during the past decade. Those members have donated almost 18,000 volunteer hours during the same time period.

The VIPS program is still running strong and we look forward to many more years of service to the City of Buckhannon and the residents and visitors of our community.

The President's Volunteer Service Award



The President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) is the premier volunteer awards program, encouraging citizens to live a life of service through presidential gratitude and national recognition.

About The President's Volunteer Service Award

Now, more than ever, our country relies on volunteers investing their time and talent to resolve the most pressing issues of our times, and Americans of all ages are responding to this call to service.

The President's Volunteer Service Award recognizes, celebrates and holds up as role models Americans making a positive impact as engaged and deeply committed volunteers. The Award enables community organizations—as Certifying and Leadership Organizations—to amplify their gratitude by joining with the President of the United States to thank their most dedicated volunteers.

In 2003, the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation launched the President's Volunteer Service Award in 2003 to recognize the importance of volunteers to America's strength and national identity, and furthermore, to honor the deeply invested volunteers whose service is multiplied through the inspiration they give others.

Today, the program continues as an initiative of the Corporation for National and Community Service, managed in partnership with Points of Light, an international nonprofit with the mission to inspire, equip, and mobilize people to take action to change the world.

The Award

Presidential recognition sets you apart from your peers. It is a tremendous honor. Even though you may not seek recognition, your example can deliver a powerful message that encourages others to take action.

The President's Volunteer Service Award recognizes United States citizens and lawfully admitted, permanent residents of the United States who have achieved the required number of hours of service over a 12-month time period or cumulative hours over the course of a lifetime.

How it Works

Criteria - Individuals, families and groups that meet the criteria are eligible for the PVSA.

- Recipient(s) must be a United States citizen or a lawfully admitted permanent resident of the United States.
- Awards are issued for service hours served within a 12-month time period or over the course of a lifetime.

- Awards are issued for volunteer service only; additional levels of participation with the
 organization (i.e., charitable support) are not a factor considered for the award.
- Court-ordered community service does not qualify for the award.
- Awards are issued by approved Certifying Organizations.
- Service must be with an approved Certifying Organization that is legally established in the United States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or one of the U.S. territories.

Eligibility

Hours are measured over a 12-month period and awards are designated based on cumulative hours. The awards are offered in multiple levels and are designed to recognize each milestone of your service achievement. Levels include bronze, silver, gold and the highest honor, the President's Lifetime Achievement Award for those who contribute more than 4,000 hours of service in their lifetime.
